1. It is time to begin planning for the year 2020-2021 competitive season. Clubs wishing to host a Competition should apply in writing using the request for competition application form to:

2. The preliminary information required by the Competitions Committee is:
  - Conditional facility hours to be booked, as per above, with no other user groups using the ice either late at night or early in the morning for a multi-day event
  - cost of ice rental per hour, (taxes included) and charge if any for rooms at the arena
  - ice surface dimensions, dedicated electrical outlets at ice surface
  - room availability of hotels/motels (approximately 20 rooms for officials need to be reserved and depending upon location approx 70 more available).
  - cost of rooms at hotels/motels
  - distance between hotels/motels and arena
  - Paramedic or Fire Department volunteers for medical coverage, (an honorarium to be given)
  - name and telephone number of proposed Chairperson(s) and support persons
4. Bids must be submitted no later than, **April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020**
5. Registration for all competitions will be done through Uplifter Nova Scotia.
6. Any Section Sponsorship must be allowed space in the program
7. For Provincial Championships, Skate Canada Nova Scotia is responsible for all ice costs, medals; officials' accommodations and transportation. Admission will be charged for these events, \$5.00 for persons over the age of 12 for the entire weekend., with the proceeds being shared between the hosting club or region and the section
