POLICY FOR COACH ASSESSOR PROMOTION

Step 1: Skate Canada eLearning courses

To become a Coach Assessor in Skills the following courses and exams must be completed.

- STAR 1-5 Assessor Training
- STAR 6- Gold: Introduction
- STAR 6- Gold: Skills

Step 2: Coach Assessor Process

Once you have successfully completed the eLearning modules and exams, submit your Coach Assessor request to the SCNS Section JET Chair Rozanne Raine; rozanne@ns.sympatico.ca. Email must include:

- Name
- Email address
- Home Address
- Phone number
- Skate Canada Number
- Star 1-5 Assessor date of completion
- Star 6- Gold Introduction completion certificate
- Star 6- Gold Skills completion certificate

Step 3: Interview and Co-evaluation Assessment

Once your information is received you will be assigned a mentor and contacted for a telephone interview by one of the SCNS STAR 6-Gold Mentor Assessors.

Upon a successful interview a supervised assessment is required where the coach will assess their skater with an assessor also evaluating. The evaluator assessment will be the official assessment that is submitted to Skate Canada. The co-evaluation assessment will be coordinated with a planned assessment day. The SCNS JET Chair will organize the timing of the mentored assessment with you and the mentor assessor.

If the coach would like to work with the mentor prior to their assessment a mentored assessment may be requested.

Step 4: Promotion

You will receive your Mentored Assessment feedback and results by email. Your Skate Canada membership will be updated with your Coach Assessor Skills designation. If the results of your Co-evaluation assessment requires further training in order to receive the promotion, the Mentor Assessor will provide the recommendations and suggestions.
