ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE (From Skate Canada Rule 5401)

Entrants in events shall be:

eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100.

- Associate Members in good standing of the Association.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY

AGE PREREQUISITES: For competitors entering the requirements for age are as of July 1st 2021.

<u>Skaters may 'skate-up' one level above their test qualifications</u> <u>Skaters may enter one singles freeskate and one singles short program event or one</u> <u>singles combined event and/or one pairs event</u>

ENTRIES AND FEES

All entries must be done online <u>skatecanadans.uplifterinc.com</u> from **December 15 2021** until **December 20**, **2021** with payment due at the time of registration by credit card. Uplifter invoice required for proof of registration. Second event discount on short programs will only be give if both programs are registered at the same time and STAR 7 & /or STAR 9 is the second event registered.

No late entries will be accepted. Registration will be closed early if maximum number of registrations are received. No refunds after close of registration. If the competition is cancelled for any reason a \$40 administration fee will be retained.

Entry fees are:

STAR 4 to Gold, PreJuvenile, Juvenile, Adult PreNovice to Senior Singles (combined two-part event) \$135.00 per skater \$220.00 per skater PreJuvenile and Juvenile Pairs PreJuvenile and Juvenile Dance PreNovice to Senior Pairs Second event (Star 7 or Star 9 Short Program) \$140.00 per team \$140.00 per team \$220.00 per team \$85.00 per skater

• Online payment with visa and mastercard only. Late entries will not be accepted. There are no refunds after the closing date of registration. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Do not use cell phones to register as the platform is not compatible.

Registering with Uplifter:

- Go to skatecanadans.uplifterinc.com
- You will be asked to set up and account if you do not already have one with your club, the message you will see is "You must login or create an account to register for events."
- As you are registering at the bottom of the page you will see "Message Lists" click yes to all, to make sure that you will receive e-mails regarding the schedule and order of skate.
- Now register each of the skaters in your family
- Once all the skaters in your family are added you can then proceed to 2022 RMM
- Click 2022 RMM on the black banner. On the registration page click on the category you are looking for and then click on REGISTER for that event
- Find the category, fill in the necessary information then confirm and choose the method of payment.
- Skate Canada Nova Scotia continues to monitor COVID-19 and the guidelines set by the Province of Nova Scotia. If any adjustments are required for the event for the health and safety of our members a communication will be issued.
- Proof of vaccination and a valid ID will be required at the facility at the time of registration for skaters, coach's officials, volunteers and spectators over the age of 12.
- All skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process. Music will only be accepted electronically in MP3 format. Music files are not kept from competition to competition.

REGISTRATION ON SITE

Registration will take place throughout the weekend at St. Margaret's Centre beginning 1 hour before the start of the first event.

CONDUCT OF COMPETITORS (Rule 7301(5))

Competitors are bound to obey implicitly the instructions of the officials in charge of the competition. A competitor, who directly or indirectly expresses her/himself in an improper manner regarding the officials or their decisions, or regarding the marking of the judges, may be suspended and/or excluded from further competition.

MUSIC

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the Performing Rights Society.

Competitors who have music composed especially for their programs, either in whole or in part, shall be responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and television, or appropriate clearance from the Performing Rights Society.

- Competitors must hand in their backup music either USB or CD
- Alternate electronic items such as iphones, tablets, etc will not be accepted.
- All music formats submitted must only include one program.
- The start of the music must be recorded with no more than 2 second lead in.
- Competitor's name and category shall be clear on the device.
- Backup USB or CD must only have skater's music on it.

COACHES ACCREDITATION

Must be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada in good standing.

NOTES

- 1. If there is only one entry in an event, that skater will be given the opportunity to skate up a category or withdraw their entry form with full refund.
- 2. Only visa or mastercard will be accepted.

All Competitive, STAR 5 to Gold Free Skate, PreJuvenile to Senior events will be accounted using the "CPC/CSS" method. STAR 4 Freeskate will be assessed to standard.

Events will be started no more than 30 minutes early. Skaters should be at the rink 1 hour prior to the start of their event.
