GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2022 Skate Canada Nova Scotia Provincial Championships will be conducted in accordance with the regulations as set forth in the Skate Canada Rulebook. If not specifically stated otherwise in this document, the normal regulations governing skating will apply as indicated in the Skate Canada Rulebook (the Technical and Event Management Handbooks, the Policies and Procedures Manual and CPC Regulations).

ENTRIES AND FEES

REGISTRATION WILL BE LIVE February 24th to 28th, 2022 at skatecanadans.uplifterinc.com. All entries must be completed online through the Skate Canada Nova Scotia Uplifter link.

No late entries will be accepted. Registration will be closed early if maximum number of registrations are received. No refunds after close of registration. If the competition is cancelled for any reason a \$40 administration fee will be retained. This fee is to cover fixed costs such as Uplifter and credit card fees as well as medals, skater gifts, etc.

All payments are via credit card, visa or mastercard. Music must be uploaded at the time of registration.

Skaters may only enter one free skate event, one short program or one combined event Skaters who have competed at Challenge in a category higher than Novice are not eligible to enter.

Registering with Uplifter:

- Go to skatecanadans.uplifterinc.com
- You will be asked to set up and account if you do not already have one with your club, the message you will see is "You must login or create an account to register for events."
- As you are registering at the bottom of the page you will see "Message Lists" click yes to all, to make sure that you will receive e-mails regarding the schedule and order of skate.
- Now register each of the skaters in your family
- Once all the skaters in your family are added you can then proceed to 2022 Provincials

- Click 2022 Provincials on the black banner. On the registration page click on the category you are looking for and then click on REGISTER for that event
- Find the category, fill in the necessary information then confirm and choose the method of payment.
- Skate Canada Nova Scotia continues to monitor COVID-19 and the guidelines set by the Province of Nova Scotia. If any adjustments are required for the event for the health and safety of our members a communication will be issued.
- Proof of vaccination and a valid ID will be required at the facility at the time of registration • for skaters, coach's officials, volunteers and spectators over the age of 12 or otherwise stated by Provincial Public Health.
- All skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process. Music will only • be accepted electronically in MP3 format. Music files are not kept from competition to competition.
- Backup USB must only have program no other media. •

All skaters and coaches must register on-site at 1 hour before their first event.

MUSIC

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the Performing Rights Society.

Competitors who have music composed especially for their programs, either in whole or in part, shall be responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and television, or appropriate clearance from the Performing Rights Society.

- Competitors must hand in their backup music either USB or CD
- Alternate electronic items such as iphones, tablets, etc will not be accepted.
- All music formats submitted must only include one program.
- The start of the music must be recorded with no more than 2 second lead in.
- Competitor's name and category shall be clear on the device.
- Backup USB or CD must only have skater's music on it.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to first, second and third place winners, for all categories accounted using CPC. STAR 4 will be ranked and assessed to standard and will receive medals for first, second and third place winners, Synchro events will be assessed to standard and receive ribbons and a certificate of achievement.

COACH ACCREDITATION

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional (Primary STARSkate) Coach Trained and must be in Good Standing with Skate Canada

Coaches must have proof of current registration and gualifications with them.

ACCIDENTS / LIABILITY

Skate Canada, Skate Canada Nova Scotia, Amherst Skating Club and the Local Volunteer Team undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by skaters. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Championships, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by or connected with, the conduct and management of the competitions and to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Section, the Volunteer Team and against their officers and their entries shall be accepted only on these conditions.

- 1. If there is only one entry in an event, that skater will be given the opportunity to skate up a category or skate an exhibition or withdraw their entry form with full refund.
- 2. Only credit cards will be accepted.

Events will be started no more than 30 minutes early. Skaters should be at the rink 1 hour prior to the start of their event.

Skaters are given 30 seconds from the time their name has been called to take their starting position.

Skaters who have issues with their music or equipment should report to the referee on the panel immediately. Follow referee's instructions how to proceed with the program.
