

SKATE NOVA SCOTIA CHALLENGE QUALIFYING CRITERIA

To promote the development of competitive skating in keeping with meaningful competition at our National qualifying events Skate Nova Scotia has approved the following criteria in naming the Challenge team:

The following jumps must be executed at a competition in the competitive 2022-2023 season.

For out of section competitions please provide a copy of the detailed assessment.

- Pre-Novice Singles - double axel or triple jump (can be “q” or “<” in either the short or free program)
- Novice Singles - double axel in both the short and free program and at least 1 triple jump (can be “q” or “<”) in either the short or free program
- Junior Singles - double axel in both the short and free programs and at least 2 different triple jumps in either program
- Senior Singles - double axel in both the short and free programs and at least 3 different triple jumps in either program

These criteria will be used in conjunction with the minimum score required. The scores for the 2022-2023 season are pending and will be posted by Skate Canada.
