

# SKATE NOVA SCOTIA CHALLENGE QUALIFYING CRITERIA

To promote the development of competitive skating in keeping with meaningful competition at our National qualifying events Skate Nova Scotia has approved the following criteria in naming the Challenge teams:

The following jumps must be executed at a competition in the competitive 2022-2023 season.

- Pre-Novice Singles - double axel or triple jump (can be “q” or “<” in either the short or free program)
- Novice Singles - double axel in both the short and free program and at least 1 triple jump (can be “q” or “<”) in either the short or free program
- Junior Singles - double axel in both the short and free programs and at least 2 different triple jumps in either program
- Senior Singles - double axel in both the short and free programs and at least 3 different triple jumps in either program

These criteria will be used in conjunction with the minimum score required. The minimum scores for the 2022-2023 season are as follows:

Pre Novice	Men 20	Women 23	Pairs 10	Dance 10
Novice	Men 27	Women 29	Pairs 13	Dance 12
Junior	Men 37.5	Women 35.5	Pairs 23	Dance 20
Senior	Men 44.5	Women 42	Pairs 34	Dance 36
